

The eventful autumn of Arte Laguna Prize: on October 2 the double exhibition opens at the Arsenale of Venice

The preview this summer in Mauritius to celebrate the 15th anniversary

VENICE - From 2 to 24 October 2021 the collective exhibition of Arte Laguna Prize returns to the iconic spaces of the Arsenale Nord in Venice. After the stop due to the well-known events related to the health emergency, the exhibition becomes biennial and presents the <u>finalists of the 14th</u> and <u>15th edition</u> of the competition. A major event where **240 works** from all over the world will be exhibited in **4,000 square meters** of exhibition space to celebrate **15 years** of Arte Laguna Prize, founded in 2006 by the **Cultural Association MoCA** of Venice.

The 240 artists selected by the international jury will exhibit works of painting, photographic art, sculpture and installation, video art and short films, performance, virtual art, digital graphics, land art, urban art and design. A 360° overview of international contemporary art enriched by an exciting program of art talks and guided tours that will enliven the Venetian autumn, an unmissable event in one of the most renowned and evocative locations of the art world.

The exhibition will combine two editions of the historic art competition and will be curated by **Igor Zanti**, director of IED Firenze and **Matteo Galbiati**, who will create a touching dialogue among the works selected from over 22,000 by the jury made up of curators, museum directors, art experts of international level.

The opening event and the awards ceremony will take place on Saturday 2 October, from 5 pm. During the evening the 7 absolute winners of the two editions will be awarded, receiving a cash prize of 10,000 euros each and also the 42 artists chosen by the international partners of Arte Laguna Prize for the participation in art residencies, gallery exhibitions, festivals, collaborations with companies and awards for the artistic reuse of recycled materials.

The Arte Laguna Prize exhibition will be an event not to be missed also to discover the works of Henry Le, the Vietnamese artist that the Cultural Association MoCA brings to Venice for the first time. The solo exhibition Soul Energy curated by Chiara Canali and set up from 2 to 12 October at Tesa 99 of the Arsenale Nord, will be a retrospective in which the artist takes to stage a series of large-scale paintings and majestic sculptures that evoke his homeland and reflect his personal artistic research.

Arte Laguna Prize continues to expand its international network by forging collaborations and offering artists unique opportunities for visibility. One of these is the **exclusive preview** of the big exhibition in October at the Arsenale of Venice which will be held from July 16 to August 14 at **the magnificent theater of the Caudan Arts Center on the island of Mauritius**. A selection of 15 finalist artists of Arte Laguna Prize will exhibit together with 15 Mauritian artists.

Arte Laguna Prize has been awarded with a medal by the President of the Italian Republic and has the patronage of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Cultural Heritage, the Ministry of the Environment and Protection of the Territory and the Sea, the Veneto Region, the Municipality of Venice, the Ca' Foscari University of Venice and the European Institute of Design.
